

## FELLOWS OF THE SYDNEY COLLEGE OF DIVINITY

- 1 There shall be Fellows of the Sydney College of Divinity, of whom there shall be not more than twenty.
- 2 The appointment of Fellows shall be as follows:-
  - (a) The foundation Fellows, of whom there shall be not more than six, shall be appointed by the Council and in any subsequent year the Council may appoint not more than two additional fellows;
  - (b) A person shall not be appointed to be a Fellow by the Council unless the appointment is agreed upon by a majority of the members of the Council.
- 3 The Council shall appoint a committee to be responsible for the nomination of Fellows and the committee may receive proposals for nomination from any of the following:-
  - (a) the Council;
  - (b) the Academic Board of the College;
  - (c) two members of the Sydney College of Divinity Limited;
  - (d) two Fellows;
  - (e) two full-time members of the academic staff of one or more of the Member Institutions of the College.
- 4 The following are eligible to be nominated as Fellows:-
  - (a) members and former members of the College or of the academic staff of Member Institutions of the College who have
    - (i) distinguished themselves by their contribution to theological education; or
    - (ii) who have rendered exceptional service to the College;
  - (b) other persons who have distinguished themselves by the ecumenical contribution to theological education and who are believed likely to contribute to the life or work of the College.
- 5 A Fellowship shall be terminated:-
  - (a) on the death of the Fellow;
  - (b) on the resignation of the Fellow;
  - (c) by decision of the Council after due process.
- 6 The Fellows shall be invited to attend formal occasions of the Council and on such occasions the order of precedence shall be: persons upon whom the College has conferred the degree of Doctor of Theology (*honoris causa*), persons whom the Council has admitted to the degrees of Doctor of Theology and Master of Theology (Honours), Fellows of the College.
