

CHANGE OF STATUS OF A MEMBER INSTITUTION

- (1) Application shall be made by the applicant Member Institution to the College through the Dean who shall advise the chairperson of the Institutional Membership Committee.
- (2) With the application shall be included a submission by the applicant Provisional Member Institution stating the grounds on which the application is made.
- (3) The Institutional Membership Committee shall:
 - (a) seek a comprehensive report from the mentor appointed to the applicant Member Institution on the suitability of such Institution being granted Member Institution status and other committee concerns as appropriate;
 - (b) examine the submission in the light of the conditions applied to the applicant Member Institution when it was granted Provisional Member status;
 - (c) take other such steps as it deems necessary to make a considered decision on the application;
 - (d) present a written report with a recommendation on the application to Council.
- (4) Council shall consider the report from the Institutional Membership Committee and make a decision on the application.
- (5) The applicant Member Institution shall be notified of the decision by the Dean.
